- **COMMUNICATED** to all professionals and board members our **commitment to a high ethical and legal standard** in sexual harassment prevention and response
- **RAISED** awareness around our current **Sexual Harassment and Assault policy** which we are continuing to update based on best practices
- **DEVELOPED** **new educational and support resources** including recorded Safe Workplace trainings, guidance on scenarios that Hillels face on campus, and a new an Investigations Guide with recommended protocols for response
- **JOINED** the **Safety Respect Equity Coalition** and ran a process to sign onto the Commitment as a Hillel movement
- **TRAINED** five Hillel professionals as Safe Workplace Trainers, who will now offer to all professionals and lay leaders **new Hillel-specific trainings** online and in-person in 2019
- **COMPILED** all of this information and resources on a new internal site for Hillel professionals
